1 Iraq Airspace

We have received confirmation that **Iraq's airspace has officially reopened** to commercial and cargo flights. While flight operations are expected to resume as early as next week, timing will depend on airline readiness and regulatory approvals. Our team is monitoring this closely and will share updates on availability and confirmed schedules as they become available.

Here's the status across transport modes:

Air Freight:

- Iraq's airspace has reopened.
- Flight operations are expected to resume next week, pending carrier and regulatory readiness.
- We will notify you as soon as bookings become available.

Sea Freight:

- Vessel calls to Umm Qasr Port continue uninterrupted.
- War Risk Surcharges (WRS) are currently being applied by NVOCCs, though this may be revised soon.

Overland Transport:

Cross-border trucking via **Safwan** and **Ibrahim Khalil** remains operational.
